SUNDAY 5th May 2024 Sixth Sunday of Easter — Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

The command to love is at the heart of Christ's life, teachings and mission. It was love that brought Christ into the world. "For God so loved the world that God gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life," (John 3:16). Christ lived for love and died for love. "Greater love has no one than



this, than to lay down one's life for one's friends," (John 15:13). The whole life of Christ was a demonstration of the command Christ gave to us. He couldn't command us to do what He wasn't prepared to do Himself. On the cross, Christ fulfilled in concrete manner the command to love.

The gospel this weekend is a continuation of the one from last weekend. The theme of "remaining or abiding" is continued. Christ continues His invitation to His disciples to 'remain or abide' in Him - not just as the Vine but also as the source of love. "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you, remain in my love. If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love," (John 15:9-10). Jesus says that to remain in His love is to keep His commandments. Ironically the evangelist presented Christ's command to love, as if there were many commandments, whereas the commandments as Christ taught them were just "love of God and love of neighbour (Mark 12:28-31; Matthew 22:36-40; Luke 10:25-27). Christ did not come to abolish the 613 commandments, which the religious teachers of His time taught and enforced, but to perfect them and make the commandments easy to observe. The religious teachers presented and taught the commandments in ways which made observing them look like an uphill task. From the ages of 13 and above, a Jewish male was expected to wear the phylacteries, which are black leather cube-shaped cases containing Torah texts written on parchment, as an obligation to keep the Law every day of his life.

In Christianity, the command to love is not an obligation as such but a way of life. Our faith is founded on love. We are called and chosen for nothing other than to love. Love is at the heart of Christianity and Christian life. Love is the primary vocation of every Christian. To say this is to say that love is all that really matters. When we love each other, truly, with the sacrificial love of Christ, everything else falls into place. St. Augustine aptly captured how love should underpin all our actions when he said: "once and for all, a short rule is laid down for you: love and do what you will. If you keep silence, do it out of love. If you cry out, do it out of love. If you refrain from punishing, do it out of love. Let the root of love be within you. From such a root, nothing but good can come."

If our parish community is to be a vibrant community and a home for all, then we need to begin to live and love genuinely. Sometimes it appears that we have a mission to fight and compete with one another or to dispute with one another or even to quarrel with one another. The danger is that when we place conflict, unhealthy competition, jealousy, and quarrels at the forefront of our relationships, we then struggle to love.

We are chosen to be friends, Christ's ambassadors and partners in the business of promoting love amongst us and in our world where many live without love. As partners and ambassadors of Christ, the only way we can attract people to our Parish and Christian faith is to show them the fruit of our Christian life which


