SUNDAY 12th May 2024 The ASCENSION of the Lord — Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

At every weekend Eucharistic celebration, major feasts or solemnity, we stand and profess that: 'Jesus Christ ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.' For forty days after His resurrection, Christ made many appearances to His apostles and



disciples to strengthen their faith before He ascended into heaven. The ascension of Christ is inextricably linked to His resurrection and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the early believers. "But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you," (John 16:7).

This weekend we celebrate the feast of the ascension of the Lord. In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Luke the Evangelist, gave what seemed like a graphic description of Christ's bodily ascension into heaven, after Christ had given the apostles their final instructions over forty days. In his account, Saint Luke seemed to imply that forty days elapsed between the resurrection and the ascension, whereas the other writers tend to assume that the ascension happened immediately after the resurrection. Saint Luke's graphic description was further explained in the second reading. In the letter to the Ephesians, Saint Paul says that the ascension of Christ is the same as the exaltation of Christ. Jesus Christ is enthroned at the right of the Father, where Christ is forever interceding for us.

As we reflect on the gospel, it's obvious that the focal point of the gospel is not so much on the ascension of the Lord but rather on the mission which the Lord Jesus Christ had entrusted to His followers. God the Father sent His Son Jesus Christ into the world with full power and authority. With the same power and authority, Christ commissioned His followers to go into the world and make a difference. "These signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will drive out demons, they will speak new languages. They will pick up serpents with their hands, and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not harm them. They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." While some of the signs like picking up serpents with hands, drinking deadly poison and be unharmed which can accompany those who believe might not necessarily be signs we associate with believers, the small and great acts of love, compassion and forgiveness we give and experience can be tangible manifestations of Christian living.

The extraordinary thing about Christianity is that it's not founded on the visions, dreams or aspirations of a dead hero but on a living Person- Jesus Christ risen from the dead. Christ is not once upon a time but an active and living presence amongst all who believe in His name. "Christ is the head of the body, the Church; He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He might come to have first place in everything," (Colossians 1:18). Pope Benedict XVI once said that the ascension is not so much the departure of Jesus as it is "the beginning of a new nearness." In the ascension, Jesus Christ becomes "the one who fills all things in every way," and it is through the ascension that Christ's promise to be with us always, until the end of the age, has been fulfilled. Therefore, rather than seeing the ascension of the Lord as an occasion to mourn the departure of Jesus, the feast of the ascension is a day to rejoice and celebrate in the nearness of Christ to us.




